Dear Colleagues:



As we discussed at our last meeting, Richard Levi and I have explored having investigators of other agencies testify with respect to their procedure and practices. Thus far we have representatives of Defense, the FBI, and Naval Investigative Services. I have contacted public interest representatives, specifically Tom Devine of General Accountability Project (GAP) and Ellyn Weiss, Esq. of the law firm of Harmon and Weiss. Both are planning to appear. Mr. Levi will be contacting the principal union which represents licensee employees. Finally, I will discuss with Mr. Charnoff whether he or other representatives of the Atomic Industrial Forum wish to appear.
