2 “(b) An offense described in this section is—

3 “(1) punishable by a fine of not more than  
4 \$50,000 or imprisonment of not more than ten years,  
5 or both—

6 “(A) in the circumstances set forth in subsec-  
7 tion (a)(1) if the damage exceeds \$100,000; and

8 “(B) in the circumstances set forth in subsec-  
9 tion (a)(2); or

10 “(2) punishable by a fine of not more than  
11 \$25,000 or imprisonment of not more than five years,  
12 or both, in any other case.

13 “(c) For purposes of this section the term ‘energy facili-  
14 ty’ means a facility that is involved in the production, stor-  
15 age, transmission, or distribution of electricity, fuel, or an-  
16 other form or source of energy, or research, development, or  
17 demonstration facilities relating thereto, regardless of wheth-  
18 er such facility is still under construction or is otherwise not  
19 functioning except a facility subject to the jurisdiction, admin-  
20 istration, or in the custody of the Nuclear Regulatory Com-  
21 mission.

22 “(d) There is Federal jurisdiction over an offense de-  
23 scribed in this section if the offense is committed on the  
24 premises of an energy facility.”.

- 1 (b) The table of contents for chapter 65 of title 18,
- 2 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end thereof
- 3 the following new item:

"1365. Aggravated property destruction of an energy facility."
