Dear Mr. Moran:

Per our telephone discussion, I am sending you and Mr. Stickley at INEL a preliminary draft of Amendment 2 to Revision 3 of EDR-1 to minimize the impact of these changes on the NRC review schedule of that revision. To facilitate the review:

- a. A change sheet for Amendment 2 has been included.
- b. An "A2" has been included in the right hand margin to identify the location of the changes in the text. However, this notation has not been used to denote deletion of dashed lines. Of course, since Appendix I is totally new A2's in the right margin have not been included in it either.
- c. The dashed line has been removed from the left margin to identify the proprietary material that has been reclassified as non-proprietary. The "A2" notation has not been used to denote deletion of dashed lines, excepting where a change in the text was needed to make the information non-proprietary.
- d. The differences between the equations of Appendix E, which had been previously accepted by the NRC, and those provided by Appendix I have been highlighted as you suggested.

Depending upon the needs of the reviewers, we can formally submit Amendment 2 next week, or we can hold up formal submittal of Amendment 2 so that any changes needed to resolve questions of the reviewers can be incorporated in it.


