Dear Mr. Wiedeman:

In response to your Notice of Violation for our license number 22-01025-01 please be advised of the following:

1. Radiation Safety meetings are now scheduled on an ongoing basis for the fourth Wednesday of each third month beginning with January of this year. The first meeting for 1983 was held March 30, 1983 with the second scheduled for June 22nd. This ongoing schedule alleviates any noncompliance in the past.
2. Instructions per attachment #2, Item 3C, I.D.6 are now written directly on the quarterly linearity graph. Percentage variations are also numerically stated on same. Corrective actions taken per instructions on the linearity graph will be documented on the back of the graph. Adherence to this procedure brings us into compliance with this condition.
3. In regards compliance with Item number 14 of Appendix F of the draft "Guide for the Preparation of Applications for Medical Programs" we are now surveying and wipe testing all incoming packages for detection of possible radioactive contamination.
4. Lastly, regarding Appendix I of the "Guide for the Preparation of Application for Medical Programs" requiring that specific laboratory areas be surveyed daily and weekly this is to inform you that we are currently surveying our preparation and injection areas and daily recording the results. In addition, a weekly wipe of the Nuclear Medicine laboratory is being performed. These actions bring us into compliance with License Condition #17, Item #17, Appendix I.


