
NUREG-0612-CONTROL OF HEAVY LOADS

In our letter dated December 15, 1982 (Serial Number 709), Vepco provided dates as requested by NRC for completion of the Special Lifting Rig Analysis being performed by Westinghouse per TER 2.1.5, Special Lifting Devices (Guideline 4, NUREG-0612, Sec. 5.1.1(4)). Upon receipt of the final Westinghouse Report and after performing an internal review and evaluation, Vepco was to submit to NRC the results no later than May 16, 1983.

Vepco received the Westinghouse Report later than originally scheduled. Due to this unanticipated delay in the receipt of the report, Vepco has not completed its internal review and evaluation, therefore, requests an extension until June 20, 1983.
