BACKGROUND

On July 13, 1994, the parties to this proceeding filed a "Joint Motion to Stay Proceeding," in which the parties requested a stay of the proceeding until August 8, 1994. The Board granted the stay on July 13, 1994. "Order (Granting Joint Motion to Stay Proceeding)."

DISCUSSION

The parties request an additional stay of this proceeding until August 31, 1994. The requests for issuance of licenses to individual facilities currently named on the Oncology Services Corporation's license is still pending with the Staff. It is estimated that

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
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the pre-licensing inspections of the facilities will occur during the first two weeks in August, and, most likely, will not be completed by the August 8, 1994 deadline for the end of the current stay of this proceeding. The parties, therefore, request an extension of the stay until August 31, 1994 to permit the completion of the pre-licensing inspections and the resolution of any other outstanding licensing issues.


### CONCLUSION

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
