The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) is considering the renewal of Special Nuclear Material License SNM-1168 for the continued operation of the Nuclear Fuel Fabrication Plant at Lynchburg, Virginia.

The Commission's Division of Fuel Cycle and Material Safety has prepared an environmental impact appraisal for the proposed renewal of license SNM-1168. On the basis of this appraisal, the Commission has concluded that the environmental impact created by the proposed license renewal action would not be significant and does not warrant the preparation of an environmental impact statement and, accordingly, it has been determined that a Negative Declaration is appropriate. The environmental impact appraisal (NUREG-0987) is available for public inspection at the Commission's Public Document Room at 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.
