This request is made pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, as amended, 5 U.S.C. §552.

I am writing to request a copy of the following document, published in November, 1982:

The "Final Environmental Impact Statement on 10 CFR Part 61 'Licensing Requirements for Land Disposal of Radioactive Waste.'" (NUREG-0945).

Under the FOIA, as amended, you are permitted to reduce or waive fees if you find that it "is in the public interest because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefitting the public." 5 U.S.C. §552(a)(4)(A). Pursuant to this provision, I am requesting a waiver of fees.


The Minnesota Project is a non-profit, tax exempt organization working in the areas of public policy analysis and community development. The Minnesota Project has been doing public education on the issue of low level radioactive waste disposal for nearly two years. The document requested will be used for public education purposes. Our goal is to inform the public on the issue of low level radioactive waste disposal so as to maintain and enhance citizen health and safety, and environmental quality, as well as to encourage public participation on this issue.

Thus, this request meets the requirements of 10 CFR §9.14a, and therefore I am requesting a waiver of any fees. If you decide not to waive fees, please state your reasons for this determination in your response.

As provided by the amended Act, I will expect to receive a reply from you within ten (10) working days from the receipt of my request. If for any reason the requested document is not mailed within the ten day time frame, I would appreciate a letter advising me as to the date I can expect to receive the requested materials.
