WE LIVE BY ROCKWELL INTERNATIONAL'S ENERGY SYSTEMS GROUP (FORMERLY ATOMICS INTERNATIONAL) FACILITIES, WHICH IS LICENSED TO HAVE UP TO NEARLY TWO TONS OF URANIUM AND PLUTONIUM ON SITE, UNDER LICENSE SNM #21.

OUR HEALTH, SAFETY, WELFARE, AND OUR FINANCIAL AND EMOTIONAL WELL-BEING ARE DIRECTLY THREATENED BY THE PRESENCE OF THESE HIGHLY DANGEROUS NUCLEAR MATERIALS IN OUR COMMUNITY, AND WE WILL BE THREATENED AS LONG AS THESE MATERIALS REMAIN IN CANOGA PARK.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, DO HEREBY REQUEST THAT THE NRC HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS BEFORE RENEWING ROCKWELL INTERNATIONAL'S LICENSE, SO THAT WE HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO BECOME FULLY INFORMED ON THIS ISSUE AND TO ALLOW FOR INPUT BY THOSE DIRECTLY AFFECTED: THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY. 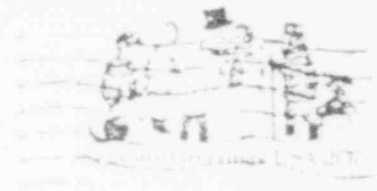


