Gentlemen:

This refers to the special inspection conducted by Mr. R. C. Brown of this office on January 6, 1983, of the activities authorized by the NRC Byproduct Material License 35-19767-01 and to the discussion of our findings held by the inspector with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. The purpose of this special inspection is described in the enclosed NRC Inspection Report 30-19209/83-01. This also refers to the Enforcement Conference held by telephone on February 9, 1983, between Mr. Don Edwards and Mr. Jerry Everett of our office to discuss the findings of the NRC inspection. The enclosed Inspection Report 30-19209/83-02 documents this Enforcement Conference.

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements, and observations by the inspector.

During this inspection one of your activities was found not to be conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements. This violation involving the over-exposure of an individual is classified as a Severity Level IV after careful consideration of the safety significance in this specific instance. Consequently, you are required to respond to this matter, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation attached to this letter.

The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If your receipt of this letter has been delayed such that less than 7 days are available for your review, please notify this office promptly so that a new due date may be established. Consistent with Section 2.790(b)(1), any such application must be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the owner of the information which identifies the document or part sought to be withheld, and which contains a full statement of the reasons on the basis which it is claimed that the information should be withheld to address, with specificity, the considerations listed in 10 CFR 2.790(b)(4). The information sought to be withheld shall be incorporated as far as possible into a separate part of the affidavit. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified periods noted above, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
