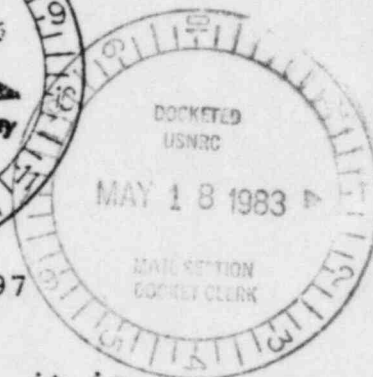

Pursuant to our discussion yesterday, it is RMEC's understanding that the Reno Creek R&D license may be extended past the September 31, 1983 expiration date to authorize decommissioning activities. RME will submit a letter requesting license extension at least 30 days prior to the expiration date. The extension request will be supported by a discussion of current and proposed site activities, status of regulatory agency decisions pertinent to restoration approval, recent environmental and personnel radiological monitoring data and other information relevant to the potential for radiological exposures.

Your concurrence on these basic provisions for license extension would be appreciated. Thank you for the time and insights given during our meeting yesterday.
