The Commission was briefed by the staff on the May 18
Inspection Report and May 19 staff views regarding
revalidation of management competence at TMI.

The Commission requested that:

1. staff provide to OGC all summaries or informal documentation
of the conclusion that leak rate falsifications did occur;

2. OGC review the material and make a recommendation to the
Commission on whether to serve it on the parties; and

oral comments from the parties on the May 18 inspection report.

in the near future.
