

SUBJECT: INVESTIGATIVE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED AT RANCHO SECO
BY NRC DURING THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 1981 THROUGH
SEPTEMBER 30, 1982

REFERENCE: Memo of D. M. Sternberg captioned SALP BOARD REVIEW
OF RANCHO SECO dated October 14, 1982

During the period related to SALP, July 1, 1981 through September 30, 1982, the Investigation section of Region V has been involved on seven investigations. Six of these cases were closed during the SALP period with no violations or citations made against the licensee. The one case that is still pending involves an allegation against some contract personnel who have worked at Rancho Seco during outages who were using controlled drugs. This case will be closed in November 1982. There will not be any citation made against the licensee.

Attached for your review is a brief description of the seven cases that were investigated during the SALP period.

5-82-012	Allegation of HP personnel of contractor using controlled drugs	5-17-81		Case will be closed in Nov. 1982 with no violation or citation against the licensee.
RV-IV-82-020	Allegation against contractor employee using controlled drug	4-2-82	4-30-82	Licensee advised of person's identity and the allegation. No violation or citation issued against the licensee.
RV-IV-81-057	Use of out of date drawings	12-11-81	12-11-81	No investigation conducted by investigative section. Matter turned over to Resident Inspector for appropriate action.
RV-IV-81-053	Allegation that there was improper reactor pressure manipulation by control room personnel	11-5-81	7-20-82	Issue was shown not to be a safety matter. Matter covered in RV report 50-312/79-14.
RV-IV-81-018	Allegations were made concerning HVAC installations.	4-13-81	7-22-81	The allegor submitted all his concerns on NCRS. The Resident Inspector monitored their dispositions and found them all to be correct.
RV-IV-81-004	Use of controlled drugs by personnel on site	2-19-81	8-21-81	Case was identified by SMUD Security Dept. who called in local law enforcement. The investigation resulted in some arrests and some terminations. No violations or citations issued against the licensee.
RV-IV-81-034	Possible theft of Star Set from NRC Inspector's office	8-5-81	7-20-82	Case involved the misplacing or theft of the Star Set which was to be an attachment to the Rovaplane. It was never found.
