
Dear Governor Riley:

I am pleased to respond to your letter of January 25, 1983 requesting a representative of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to attend the next meeting of your Committee on Away-From-Reactor Storage.

You indicated that the Committee meeting on February 17, 1983 will focus on implications for South Carolina and South Carolina utilities of the spent fuel storage provisions contained in the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1982. We are in the early stages of our assessment of the Act and its requirements for NRC actions, but we will be pleased to send a representative to your meeting to outline NRC responsibilities related to spent fuel storage, as specified by the Act.
