Dear Dr. Clark:

This is in response to your letter of December 13, 1982 to Chairman Palladino. Thank you for taking the time to express so clearly the concerns of the Test, Research and Training Reactors (TRTR) group with the plans we have been developing for transferring certain non-power reactor licensing functions to the regional offices. We also received a letter on the same subject from Mr. Wade Richards, representing the ANS-15 standards committee. I also want to thank the representatives of your group for coming to Washington for the follow-up meeting with Mr. Stello and me.

As a result of these communications, we have temporarily delayed the transfer of non-power reactor licensing functions to the regions while we review our posture. I have also advised the Commissioners that the concerns you have expressed are persuasive and following our review we will make recommendations appropriate to the unique licensing requirements of non-power reactors.

Our over-all plan at this time includes holding public meetings for discussions with licensees and others affected by the regionalization of power reactor licensing functions. Input from members of the research, test, and training reactor community at these meetings is also encouraged. Announcements of the meetings will be made by appropriate means in the near future.

I hope we can also call on you for specific additional information if we find it would assist us in our deliberations. In this regard, just as you have expressed a sense of success in dealing with our staff in recent years, we find it gratifying to know that your organization provides us with consensus viewpoints of the non-power reactor community.
