INTERVENORS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT PROPOSED FINDINGS

Intervenors UCS, NYPIRG, FOE, Audubon, New York City Council, Parents Concerned About Indian Point, Greater New York Council on Energy and West Branch Conservation Association, Wespac, and RCSE move the Board to extend the time for filing proposed findings of fact from June 27, 1983 until July 11, 1983.

The above-listed parties are filing a consolidated set of findings. It has become clear that the massive task of reviewing the transcript, preparing findings, circulating drafts for review and revision and final production cannot be accomplished by June 27, 1983.

Craig Kaplan, Counsel for the New York City Council, and one of the key participants in this joint process, suffered the death of his father on June 15, 1983, following surgery a few weeks previously. Mr. Kaplan has, as a result, been unable to devote substantial attention to the findings for the
