



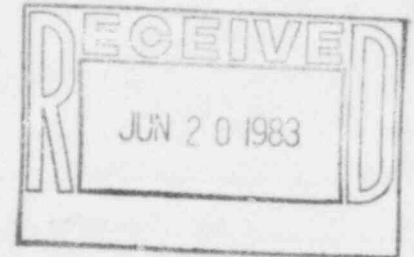

Notification of the Use of Respiratory Protective
Equipment Under the Provisions of 10 CFR 20.103

Dear Mr. Collins:

Pursuant to paragraph (e) of 10 CFR 20.103, Louisiana Power & Light Company is hereby notifying your office of its planned use of respiratory protective equipment under the provisions of the subject section of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Use of respiratory protective equipment to reduce exposure to radionuclides is not anticipated prior to fuel load, however, the Radiological Respiratory Protection Program is in place at this time, and the requirement is that notification be made at least thirty days prior to first use of the equipment under the provisions of said section.
