SUBJECT: FINDINGS RELATED TO THE PROPOSED IMPORT OF IRRADIATED FUEL
SEGMENTS FROM NORWAY-ISNM83001

On January 6, 1983 General Electric Company requested a license authorizing the import of 17 kilograms of uranium, containing 250 grams of U-235 and 110 grams of plutonium, in 22 irradiated fuel segments.

Packaging will be the GE600 or 1600 series casks, certificate numbers USA/5980/B () or USA/9044 B (). Surface transportation will be utilized.

This proposed import is similar to several other imports of irradiated test fuel segments, for instance, see ISNM79009, which have taken place without incident.

The staff finds that this import will not be inimical to the common defense and security, will not constitute an unreasonable risk to the health and safety of the public and will have no significant environmental impact.
