NRC STAFF MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

I. THE MOTION

The NRC Staff hereby moves for an extension of time until July 1, 1983 for submission of reply briefs to the Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law filed in this proceeding, for the reason discussed below.

II. DISCUSSION

After completion of the May 24-26 hearings concerning Contention II, the Alternate Board Member directed all parties to the proceeding to file their proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law simultaneously on June 20, 1983 by express mail, and to file reply briefs on June 27, 1983 also by express mail. Special Proceeding, Tr. 779.

The Staff served its Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law by express mail on June 20, 1983. However, Staff learned on June 23, 1983 through telephone inquiry that the University and Intervenor, CBG, filed their Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law on June 23,



1983. Therefore, Staff will not have received the documents from University and Intervenor to which it is to respond until Monday, June 27, 1983, so that it will be impossible for Staff to file a reply to University and CBG by that date. In view of the above circumstances, the Staff requests an extension of time until July 1, 1983 for all replies to the parties' Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. Upon inquiry by telephone, both Mr. Cormier representing UCLA and Ms. Thompson representing CBG supported Staff's request for extension of time.


