Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge your application dated July 2, 1957 for license to obtain a plutonium-beryllium neutron source containing about one curie of plutonium.

Plutonium is a special nuclear material and its receipt, possession, and use must be licensed in accordance with Part 70, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations enclosed. Section 70.22 of the regulations pertains to applications for licenses. An application should be submitted in letter form in quadruplicate and signed under oath or affirmation. Compliance with 10 CFR 20, enclosed, is made a condition of all licenses.

In describing your procedures to protect health, please provide more detailed information on the storage containers that will be used to prevent exposure of personnel to the source when it is not in use. The information contained in the referenced July 2, 1957 letter may be incorporated by reference in any future application you may submit for license for a plutonium-beryllium source.
