Dear Mr. Allan:

This transmission confirms the telephone report of May 15, 1983, by F.T. Eisenhuth to G.G. Rhoads of your staff, regarding interactions of the chlorine detector in the Control Room Emergency Outside Air Supply System (CREOASS) following a loss of power. Procedure changes have been instituted to provide operators with appropriate actions to ensure proper response of CREOASS. Any further corrective actions deemed necessary will be discussed in subsequent reports.

This condition is considered reportable in accordance with Technical Specification 6.9.1.8.i.
