SUBJECT: ORDER PROHIBITING INVOLVEMENT IN NRC-LICENSED ACTIVITIES
(EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY)

The enclosed Order is being issued because of your violations of 10 CFR 30.10 of the Commission's regulations as described in the Order.

Based on an investigation conducted by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Office of Investigation, the NRC Staff has determined that you deliberately conspired with other AMSPEC officials to deceive the Commission and provided false testimony, under oath, to NRC officials. In addition, you deliberately failed to train and certify employees in radiation safety as required by the NRC license conditions. A copy of the synopsis of the investigation is enclosed.

Failure to comply with the provisions of this Order may result in further civil or criminal sanctions.
