Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted under the Resident Inspector Program by Messrs. G. L. Constable and T. A. Flippo of this office during the period May 1-31, 1983, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit CPPR-103 for the Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3, and to the discussion of our findings with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included preoperational test procedure review, preoperational test witnessing, emergency drill postponement, emergency operating procedures review, Hayward Tyler pump question, training, concrete common foundation mat, and human engineering walkdown. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. These findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to this violation, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter.

One open item is identified in paragraph 7 of the enclosed inspection report.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within 10 days of the date of this letter, and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within 30 days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).
