The purpose of this modification is to (1) correct administrative data recorded on the previous modification changing the project officer's name, and (2) amend sections H and I. Accordingly, the following changes are made.

1. Although page 1 correctly identified the amendment/modification no. as Five (5), page 2 should be corrected to read "Modification No. 5." In addition, the transmittal letter dated 11/22/93 should transmitted Modification No. 5, not Modification No. 4.

2. Section H.6, Government Furnished Equipment/Property - None Provided (Jun 1988), is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following clause:

"H.6 Contractor Acquired Government Equipment/Property (Jun 1988)

The Contractor is authorized to acquire and/or fabricate the equipment/property listed in the individual task orders for use in the performance of this task order. The equipment/property is subject to the provisions of the "Government Property" clause.

3. The following clauses are hereby added to Section H and read as follows:

Any necessary purchases for equipment/supplies directly associated with this effort made by the Contractor shall be in accordance with FAR 52.245-5 which is incorporated herein by reference. In such event, the Contractor shall submit copies of the paid invoice/receipt to the NRC Contracting Officer listed under Section F.5 herein and to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Division of Contracts and Property Management, Attn: Mr. Art Correria, Property Officer, Property and Procurement Branch, Mail Stop P-841, Washington, DC 20555.

Within thirty days prior to the expiration of this task order, the Contractor shall submit a definitive listing of all equipment purchased under this task order. The addresses for such submittal is the same as in the above paragraph. Any contaminated equipment on the listing must be identified.

(End of Clause)"

"H.10 Disposal of Equipment

The disposition of equipment shall be by the NRC in accordance with Chapter 101-43 of the Federal Property Management Regulations.

It is understood that in the event NRC determines that equipment purchased under this contract shall be returned to NRC, costs associated with the return will be negotiated as a separate cost under the task order prior to task order expiration.

4. FAR clause 52.245-5, Government Property (Cost-Reimbursement, Time-and-Material, or Labor-Hour Contracts) (Jan 1986) is incorporated by reference.
