RE: ANTISTATIC GUN LOSS

Sir,

On or about February 4, 1994 with the cooperation of AUTOBODY SUPPLY (Ph # 471-6466) we leased one (1) antistatic blow gun model # P-2051AB serial # 64467 containing less than .0001uCi of Polonium-210 (please see attached for more information) to be used in our shop for the final prep before painting.

February 22, 1994 was the first day that the gun was needed, but after looking for the gun it was no where to be found. The same day NRD was notified of the loss, and their recommendation was to call NRC and explain what had appened.

Because the gun was never used no individual was exposed to radiation. The only action that was ever taken was the search of the building to see if the gun could be found. As of today no other gun has been purchased, so no protective measures have been attempted to assure us of another mishap.
