SUBJECT: CLASSIFICATION OF FINAL REPORT ON A3044, CONSEQUENCE ESTIMATION

I was informed this afternoon by Robert Whipp, Division of Security, that his preliminary review indicated that the draft of the Volume 1, Summary of the subject report will require classification at a Confidential/NSI or higher level. I informed Bob Whipp that I wanted to discuss the decision in more detail with him to determine what action, if any, might be taken to keep the final report in an unclassified form. He will call me soon to set a time.

I have called Jack Cusack, BNL and Dean Kaul, SAI, to notify them of the above and to instruct them to insure that all copies of the draft report are treated as classified documents until a final determination of classification is made.

I have informed Richard Major, ACRS, of this decision and have requested that he regain control of the draft reports which I furnished him on June 17, 1980. This will also require that this portion of the June 26, 1980 ACRS meeting be held in closed session.

I have placed our copy of the report summary under control.
