Dear Sir or Madam:

The purpose of this letter is to request an amendment to the American Electric Power Service Corporation's By-Product Material License No. 34-24830-01, Docket/Reference No. 030-29644. This license permits the applicant to receive, inspect, store, possess, use, and transfer by-product material until December 31, 1991.

We request that our original application dated November 26, 1986 and subsequent Amendments to the application dated July 9, 1987 and February 9, 1990 for this by-product material license be amended. Our specific requests and the reasons for them are given below.

Proposed Changes

- 1). Add the following license conditions:
 - a). 8A. Total Cs-137 activity not to exceed 500 mCi
No single source to exceed 10 mCi
 - b). 8B. Total Am-241 activity not to exceed 2000 mCi
No single source to exceed 50 mCi
- 2). Revise the addresses listed for the facilities listed to License Condition 10:

- b). AEP Civil Engineering Laboratory
4001 Bixby Road

(12 miles southeast of Columbus, OH)
 - c). All other facility addresses contained in
this License Condition are correctly listed.
- 3). Revise the person named as the Corporate Radiation
Protection Officer to Dane R. Williams.
 - 4). Delete License Condition 18.

Reasons for Proposed Changes


- 1) We are requesting a possession limit for our license that is significantly less than the limit for which decommissioning financial assurances are required. These possession limits will significantly simplify our efforts to comply with 10CFR30.35.
- 2) The requested amendment to License Condition 10 corrects a typographical error in the address listed for the John E. Amos Plant and corrects the address for the AEP Civil Engineering Laboratory. The address for the John E. Amos Plant should indicate that the facility is located in West Virginia, not Virginia. The address listed in the license for the AEP Civil Engineering Laboratory is actually the address for the Service Corporation Headquarters. As indicated in Attachment II of our request for license amendment dated February 9, 1990, the 1 Riverside Plaza address does not serve either as a storage or use location for the licensed devices. All other facility addresses listed in our current license are correct.
- 3) Mr. Dane R. Williams has replaced Mr. S. P. Klementowicz as the American Electric Power Service Corporate's Radiation Protection Officer. Mr. Williams has a Master of Science degree in Environmental and Industrial Health from the University of Michigan (1987), and a Bachelor of Science degree in Biomedical Sciences from the Western Michigan University (1981). Mr. Williams has seven years of radiation protection experience, of which the past three years have been as a professional health physicist and a radiation protection supervisor.
- 4) Since we are requesting a possession limit for our license which is significantly less than the limit for which decommissioning financial assurances are required, License Condition 18 is no longer necessary.

License No. 34-24830-01 for which this amendment is requested is a Category 3P material license per 10 CFR 170.31. As required by Part 170, Subsection 31, a check in the amount of \$60 covering the amendment fee accompanies this submittal.
