ORDER

(Granting Joint Intervenor's  
Requests For Extensions Of Time)

1. Joint Intervenor's Request For An Extension Of Filing Date of March 29, 1983, sought a seven day extension of time, to and including March 30, 1983, within which to file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. In a telephone conversation on March 22, Applicant and Staff had stated they would have no objections to the granting of such a request. Accordingly, Joint Intervenor's request is granted.

2. On April 1, 1983, Joint Intervenor, in effect, filed a motion (a) requesting leave to file out-of-time a request for an extension of time and (b) requesting a one day extension of time, from March 30 to April 1, 1983, within which to file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. Joint Intervenor has shown good cause in support of their motion by advising that a member of their volunteer


secretarial staff had to be replaced. Accordingly, their motion is granted.

3. The Staff shall have until April 12, 1983, within which to file proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and brief.

Applicant shall have until April 22, 1983, within which to reply.
