Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, I hereby request access to the following documents, including but not limited to notes, letters, memoranda, drafts, minutes, diaries, logs, calendars, tapes, transcripts, summaries, interview reports, procedures, instructions, engineering analyses, drawings, files, graphs, charts, maps, photographs, agreements, handwritten notes, studies, data sheets, notebooks, books, telephone messages, computations, interim and/or final reports, status reports, and any and all other records relevant to or generated in connection with:


The radioactive contamination of General Electric and E.H. Hinds contract employees at the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Plant on September 12, 1990 and September 13, 1990.

This includes, but is not limited to, the employment records of all contaminated workers, including names, addresses, and telephone numbers; names of supervisory personnel on duty during all three shifts on 9/12/90 and 9/13/90; records of all relevant radiation work permits (RWP's) for 9/12/90 and 9/13/90; personnel dosimetry records for all contaminated workers for these two dates; whole body count records for all contaminated workers for these two dates; all memoranda and other correspondence concerning this incident from Vermont Yankee to the NRC, and from the NRC to Vermont Yankee; all relevant correspondence, memoranda and records of the resident NRC inspectors; all relevant memoranda and documentation from the Vermont Yankee health physics radiation protection department; all relevant memoranda, documentation from the Vermont Yankee medical services supervising and any other pertinent records, including memoranda or correspondence from Robert Sojka, Warren Murphy, Robert Leach, or Gary Weisand, all of Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corporation, relevant to this contamination incident and its subsequent investigation.

I request that fees be waived. The production of this information is in the public interest, and will contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations and activities of the government. 5 U.S.C. §552(a)(4)(A).

I look forward to hearing from you within 10 days, as the law stipulates.
