Dear Mr. Stoiber:

Enclosed please find a letter from General Electric Company with a request to amend its export license XSNM01645 to add the ENUSA fuel fabrication facility as an intermediate consignee. The license now permits exports of LEU to Spain's Nuclenor reactor. You will note this is General Electric's second request to add ENUSA as an intermediate consignee. The first request was withdrawn by General Electric's letter dated March 3.

While the NRC has the authority to approve this request without referral to the Executive Branch, we are forwarding this request to the Executive Branch in light of uncertainty over the status of IAEA safeguards arrangements at ENUSA.

We would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the addition of the ENUSA fabrication facility meets the applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 as amended by the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Act of 1978.
