NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF LICENSE AMENDMENT

No request for a formal hearing having been filed following publication of the notice of proposed action in the Federal Register, the Atomic Energy Commission has issued, effective as of the date of issuance, Amendment No. 3 to Operating License No. DPR-4. The license authorizes Saxton Nuclear Experimental Corporation to operate its pressurized water reactor located near the Borough of Saxton in Liberty Township, Bedford County, Pennsylvania. Amendment No. 3 authorizes the licensee to operate the reactor with Core II at power levels up to a maximum of 35 megawatts (thermal) for up to 3500 megawatt days.

The license amendment was issued in the form published in the Notice of Proposed Issuance of Operating License Amendment in the Federal Register on January 6, 1968, 33 FR 235.
