Subject: Combined Inspection Report Nos. 50-245/83-01; 50-336/83-01

This refers to the routine safeguards inspection conducted by R. J. Bailey of this office on January 24-28, 1983, at Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2, Waterford, Connecticut, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. DPR-21 and DPR-65, and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Bailey with Mr. Mroccka of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Mr. Bailey and Mrs. T. Weekly on February 9, 1983.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the NRC Region I Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the violations brought to your attention in the enclosure to our letters dated November 27, 1981 and April 14, 1982. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were observed.

A section of the enclosed inspection report contain details of your security program that have been determined to be exempt from public disclosure in accordance with either 10 CFR 73.21 (Safeguards Information) or 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) (Commercial or Financial Information). Therefore, the section so identified in the inspection report will not be placed in the NRC Public Document Room and will receive limited distribution.
