Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter dated March 11, 1983, which included a copy of Consumers Power Company's Scope and Objectives for the Palisades Plant Emergency Exercise scheduled for May 24-25, 1983. In addition to the eleven objectives provided in your correspondence, we expect that you will also demonstrate the capability of performing a site assembly and of identifying missing personnel within 30 minutes. Regarding Objective 2.2.8, we expect that you will demonstrate the capability of actually collecting and analyzing at least one post accident sample under simulated elevated radiation levels and within the time periods stated in NUREG-0737, Item II.B.3. Finally, we expect the wording of Objective 2.2.9 to mean that your capability of determining and making protective action recommendations to offsite authorities will be demonstrated, while sheltering or evacuating segments of the local population will be simulated.
