Dear Mr. Borchardt:

Enclosed with this letter is a report describing the results of tests performed at the AP600 Core Makeup Tank Test Facility. This Quick Look Data Report (QLR) summarizes the test conditions and measured data for series 100 matrix tests.

The purpose of these data reports is to provide the NRC staff with information on AP600 matrix tests of sufficient depth to enable early evaluation and analysis of test results.

An electronic copy of the test data included in the QLR is provided as Enclosure 2 on two 3.5" diskettes.

The QLR and diskettes contain Westinghouse proprietary information and is identified as preliminary. This information will be incorporated in the Final Test Report. With the publication of the Final Test Report, the preliminary identification will be removed and a non-proprietary version of the Final Test Report will be prepared.


