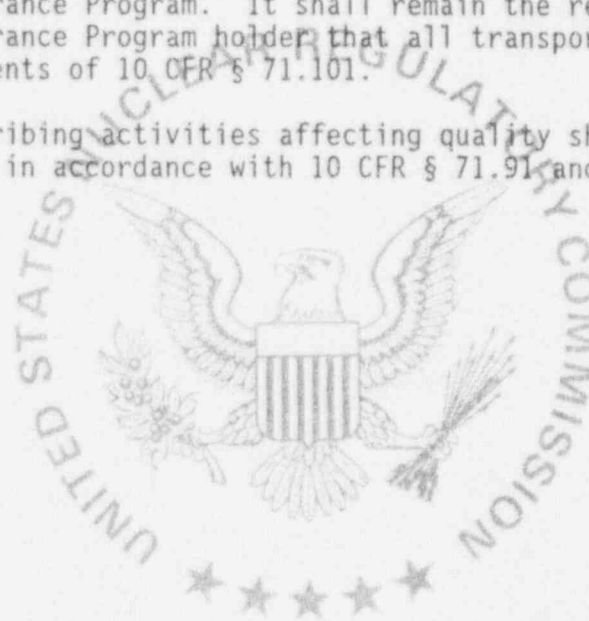

It shall remain the responsibility of the Quality Assurance Program holder that all transportation activities meet the requirements of 10 CFR § 71.101.
- Records describing activities affecting quality shall be retained for three years, in accordance with 10 CFR § 71.91 and § 71.135.
