SUBJECT: WITHDRAWAL OF AN AMENDMENT REQUEST, HOPE CREEK GENERATING STATION
(TAC NO. 73065)

By letter dated December 23, 1988, Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) applied for an amendment to Hope Creek Generating Station Operating License No. NPF-57. The proposed change would have modified the facility technical specifications pertaining to Main Steam Isolation Valve leakage limits.

By letter dated April 4, 1991, PSE&G submitted a revised version of the amendment request that also included applications for specific exemptions from 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix J and from 10 CFR Part 100, Appendix A. This second submittal replaced the first PSE&G request in its entirety. Subsequently, by letter dated April 19, 1991, PSE&G withdrew the December 23, 1988 amendment request.

The December 23, 1988, request was not noticed in the Federal Register. Therefore, no further action is required and this TAC is closed.
