Subject: INFORMATION ON ISOLITE SOURCES

Dear Mr. Taylor:

Thank you for your letter of January 11 providing information on the relationship of brightness to millicurie content of your Isolite sources.

This information will definitely be of assistance to us in reviewing your customers' applications for Isolite sources. Since this relationship varies considerably for different phosphors, it appears that it will still be necessary to request each of your customers to indicate the specific amount of radioisotope which will be incorporated into each of the sources which they procure. We should, therefore, like to suggest that you encourage your customers to state specifically on their applications: (1) the model number of the source or sources; (2) the number of sources desired; (3) the radioisotope for which they are applying; and (4) the amount of radioisotope in millicuries which will be incorporated into each source. This information will make it possible for us to materially expedite our review of their applications.
