Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Evelyn R. Matson of this office on April 15, 1991, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 21-10717-01 and to the discussion of her findings with Mr. R. Harris of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice, and a written response is required.
