This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. P. M. Byron, R. K. Walton and A. Dunlop of this office on March 6, 1991 through April 22, 1991, of activities at Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station authorized by Facility Operating License No. NPF-3 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. L. Storz at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements. The violation is not being cited because the criteria specified in Section V.A. of the Enforcement Policy were satisfied. The inspection showed that action had been taken to correct the identified violation and to prevent recurrence. Our understanding of your corrective actions are described in Paragraph 8 of the enclosed inspection report. Consequently, no reply to this violation is required and we have no further questions regarding this matter at this time.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
