SUBJECT: STAFF REQUIREMENTS - BRIEFING ON COMMITTEE TO
REVIEW GENERIC REQUIREMENTS (CRGR) PROCESS
(SECY-91-037), 10:00 A.M., FRIDAY, FEBRUARY
22, 1991. COMMISSIONERS' CONFERENCE ROOM, ONE
WHITE FLINT NORTH, ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND (OPEN
TO PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

The Commission was briefed by the NRC staff and the CRGR on the proposed revision to the CRGR Charter, incorporation of the safety goals into the CRGR process, and recent activities of the CRGR.

The Commission expressed concern that the 10 CFR 50.54(f) process improperly may be imposing requirements on utilities through the extraction of commitments in responding to these generic communications. The CRGR should continue to review generic requirements for this type of indirect method of imposing requirements.

The Commission requested that the staff keep it informed of progress in incorporating the safety goals into the CRGR process and eventual inclusion in the CRGR Charter.

The CRGR should remain cautious that the requirements of Section III of the Charter do not exceed the capabilities of the CRGR staff.

Commissioner Curtiss requested further information in the following areas.

1. How much consideration does the CRGR give to the cumulative effect of requirements imposed on licensees, and in particular, the total impact of those requirements which are considered to be backfits? Are these impacts quantified on a regular or periodic basis?

2. Is the desire to avoid backsliding by licensees legally or factually sufficient justification for finding a substantial increase in overall protection that would support backfitting?
