SUBJECT: BOMB THREAT

At 1:08 p.m. today, an apartment manager in Southport, N.C., received a telephoned bomb threat from an unidentified individual saying: "A bomb at the nuclear plant is to go off at 2 o'clock."

The apartment manager notified the Southport Police Department, which notified Carolina Power and Light Company at the Brunswick site. A search is being conducted.

CP&L notified the Brunswick County sheriff's office and the FBI.

Media interest has not occurred. Neither the licensee nor the NRC plans to issue a news release. The State of North Carolina has been informed. The Information Assessment Team was notified.

This PN is issued for information only. No further action by Region II is anticipated. A telephoned bomb threat occurred at this site on March 19 (PNO-II-82-30).

Region II (Atlanta) received notification of this occurrence by telephone from the licensee at 1:45 p.m. on March 23.
