SUBJECT: DUMPING OF RADIOACTIVE WASTE IN ATTLEBORO AND
NORTON, MASSACHUSETTS (91N-02)

The attached letter from John W. Sullivan is provided for your information and whatever action you deem appropriate. In his letter, Sullivan expressed concern over the way the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) was regulating radioactive waste sites in Norton and Attleboro, Massachusetts. NRC's performance with respect to the concerns raised by Sullivan was examined in an Office of the Inspector General (OIG) inspection, and we determined that the NRC is addressing the problems associated with contamination at material facilities sites nationwide. There were no issues identified in the Sullivan letter warranting further action by OIG at this time.
