FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Dear Mr. Felton:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 USC § 552, as amended, and the provisions of 10 CFR Part 9, the undersigned hereby requests the following items:

1. All draft responses to Ohio Citizens for Responsible Energy ("OCRE") Sixth Set of Interrogatories to the NRC Staff, dated September 13, 1982, in the OL proceeding for the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Docket Nos. 50-440/441, prepared by persons in the following branches of the NRC: RSB, CSB, SEB, or AEB, or any other person on the Staff. (See attached memo.)
2. All draft responses to the five questions posed by the Perry ASLB at p. 8 of its December 23, 1982 Memorandum and Order (Concerning Discovery from Staff on Hydrogen Issue) prepared by any person or branch of the NRC, but especially the AEB. (Again, see attached memo.)
3. Any minutes, memoranda, agenda, notes, etc. prepared during or concerning the meetings held on January 4, 1983 or January 21, 1983 pertaining to Staff responses to either OCRE's Sixth Set of Interrogatories or the Board Questions. (Again, see attached memo.)
4. All draft responses prepared by any person on the NRC Staff, including the Region III office and the Perry Resident Inspector, Max Gildner, to Sunflower Alliance et al. Third Set of Interrogatories (With Requests for Production of Documents) to NRC Staff, dated September 30, 1982, in the Perry OL proceeding.
5. All draft responses prepared by any person on the NRC Staff to OCRE's Seventh Set of Interrogatories to NRC Staff, dated September 27, 1982, in the Perry OL proceeding.

In accordance with the Commission's policy as related in your response to my earlier request, FOIA-81-516, I request that 75% of the fees for the search and production of these documents be waived, as they relate to issues admitted into the Perry proceeding: Items 1-3 above concern Issue #8 (see LBP-82-15, 15 NRC 555); Item 4 concerns Issue #3 (see LBP-81-24, 14 NRC 175); Item 5 concerns Issue #6 (see LBP-81-24). I agree to accept the residual (25%) charges.
