MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

On May 4, UCLA filed a "Motion for Reconsideration of Board's April 22, 1983 Order." This motion is directed to our disposition of the motions for summary disposition of Contention II and, rather than seeking reconsideration of our interpretation of 10 CFR § 50.22, instead seeks clarification of the scope of the proceedings before the Alternate Board Member. (Motion, p. 4.)

Because the parties have not had an opportunity to respond to this motion, and because of the impending proceedings before the Alternate Board Member, we believe this matter should be handled by the Alternate Board Member.

In referring this motion to the Alternate Board Member, we note our preliminary views that while the subjects which UCLA wishes explored seem appropriate to the proceedings before the Alternate, we also note




that UCLA seems to draw a distinction between the facility (apparently the Nuclear Energy Laboratory) and the reactor. Such a distinction may or may not be appropriate.
