ORDER

August 17, 1983

In an order issued July 27, 1983, we directed Joint Intervenors to show cause by August 8, 1983, why they should not be found in default for failure to file a brief in support of their June 10 exceptions to the Licensing Board's last partial initial decision (LBP-83-27, 17 NRC __ (May 26, 1983)). We have received neither a response to the show cause order nor a brief. Accordingly, Joint Intervenors' exceptions are dismissed. Public Service Co. of Indiana (Marble Hill Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1 and 2), ALAB-461, 7 NRC 313, 315 (1978).

ALAB-689, 16 NRC 887, 890 (1982). Also pending before us is Joint Intervenors' motion to reopen on the basis of newly discovered cracks in the slab on which the Waterford facility rests. We will take up both matters following receipt of replies to the motion to reopen.
