Dear Mr. Alley:

This is in response to your letter dated May 5, 1983 in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, three categories of information pertaining to a site investigation at Research Medical Center.

This document is exempt pursuant to exemptions (7)(A), (7)(C), (7)(D) and (6) of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(A), (7)(C), (7)(D) and (6)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(7)(i), (7)(iii), (7)(iv) and (6) of the Commission's regulations because disclosure of this information would interfere with an ongoing investigation; would cause an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy; and would disclose the identity of a confidential source.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure, and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for this denial are the undersigned and Mr. James G. Keppler, Regional Administrator, RIII.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission's Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. As provided in 10 CFR 9.11, any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."
