Gentlemen:

This refers to your June 14, 1983, request for additional information concerning Inspection Report 50-317/83-03, 50-318/83-03; regarding the performance of maintenance work using drawings which were not the latest revision. The General Supervisor-Electrical and Controls has briefed all Unit Supervisors and technicians on the violation and has reinstructed them on the use of controlled prints and aperture cards. Similar reinstruction for appropriate Operations, Mechanical Maintenance and Modifications personnel will be completed by July 15, 1983. When other changes to the controlling Quality Assurance Procedure are completed, appropriate instruction will be given. This reinstruction will address Action Items 1 and 4 in our original response and your concerns for the use of hard copy prints.

Currently, we are investigating the possibility of reinstalling an aperture card and microfiche reader/printer reproduction facility at a central location utilizing a dedicated operator. Any prints made at this central facility would be verified as current prior to distribution. This verification would be performed through the Print Room. If the latest revisions are not available at the central facility, the requestor will be referred to the Print Room to obtain a copy of the latest revision. Changes implemented per this proposal, will be appropriately included in plant procedures.

Should you have further comments or questions regarding this response, we would be pleased to discuss them with you.
