- A. Identification of John Montgomery as listed in item one (1).
- B. What was Mr. Montgomery's request, and the background of that request?
- C. Was Scullin told, item two (2), that the Institute for Nuclear Medical Education (INME) course is listed on the Service and Training Information System (STIS)?
- D. Identify the individuals who received copies, and what their relationship is to this matter.

II. Letter to Spell - undated.

- A. What were the comments received by the NRC from Spell on July 5, 1989?
- B. What are the lapses referred to in item one (1) of that letter, and do any of the lapses, in any way, relate to our organization? If yes, provide us with specific relationships and details.


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- C. Is there any evidence of false or misleading statements in applications relating to our organization? (Item 2)

- G. What controversy has been referred to the appropriate NRC offices for further consideration, and provide us with copies of those documents.
