SUBJECT: SYSTEMATIC ASSESSMENT OF LICENSEE PERFORMANCE

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has completed its periodic evaluation of the performance of your reactor facilities. As you are aware, this evaluation program, the Systematic Assessment of Licensee Performance (SALP), involved an assessment of facility performance by the NRC staff; the issuance of the staff's findings in the form of a final report, the SALP Board Assessment (Enclosure 1); a meeting with senior staff of your utility on March 17, 1983, in your offices in Atlanta, Georgia to present and discuss the Board Assessment (Enclosure 2); your response to the SALP Board Assessment (Enclosure 3); and the approval and public distribution of the SALP report by the Regional Administrator.

In accordance with the NRC policy, I have reviewed the SALP Board Assessment and, as Regional Administrator, approve the issuance of the report. It is my view that Georgia Power Company's conduct of nuclear activities shows a proper concern for nuclear safety and the company's resources are being properly applied.

The overall performance of your Hatch facility indicated that proper management attention was applied to the conduct of nuclear activities, and that satisfactory performance with respect to operational safety was achieved. No major weaknesses were identified during the assessment period. The SALP Board recognized, and I agree, that a high level of performance was achieved in the area of licensing activities.

In regard to the Vogtle facility, your resources were adequate and reasonably effective such that satisfactory regulatory performance was attained. No major weaknesses were identified during the assessment period. Your performance in the areas of containment and other safety related structures, and licensing activities, was commended by the SALP Board.

No reply to this letter is required; however, should you have any questions concerning these matters, I will be pleased to discuss them with you.
