SUBJECT: EXPIRED LICENSE, CLOROX COMPANY, JERSEY CITY, NEW JERSEY

On February 14, 1983, a licensee representative, John Feltz, Plant Manager, was contacted and informed that License No. 29-15109-01 had expired on April 30, 1982 and that no renewal application had been received. The licensee representative explained that they had received or possessed licensed material, but now possess no licensed material and wish to have the license terminated.

Licensed material was disposed of by transfer to Texas Nuclear Corporation, Texas License No. 6-1825. This was confirmed in a letter from the licensee dated March 24, 1983 (copy enclosed).

Based on a review of the information supplied by the licensee and a review of the type and form of material authorized by the license, a closeout survey by the licensee is not required and this license may be retired.


Based on the above information, we have retired License No. 29-15109-01. Please remove it from your active shelves.


